EXHIBITIONS

May 26-29, 2026

Ministry of the Russian Federation for Civil Defence, Emergencies and Elimination of Consequences of Natural Disasters (EMERCOM): fire and rescue equipment, retro equipment, interactive demining sites (demonstrations of personal protective equipment for EOD specialists, operations of miner drones), canine teams, organic equipment, including UAVs, electronic warfare, telecommunications systems, communications equipment, diving and climbing kits, expositions stands of the ministry's educational and research organizations, a display of the EMERCOM's Psychological Service with workshops, the 'First Aid' display with practical training on dummies.

Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation: specialized transport, weapons, personal armor protection and non-lethal assets, forensic, search and inspection special equipment, a thematic exhibition stand with information on training programs for representatives of foreign law enforcement agencies in educational institutions of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia.

Federal Service of the National Guard of the Russian Federation: 'Educational organizations of the Russian National Guard in the System of National Security of Russia' and 'Educational and Demonstration Complex of Technologies for Training UAV operators', demonstration of technical means of ensuring security used by units of non-departmental security of the National Guard of the Russian Federation, demonstration site for the use of tracker dogs in combination with technical means.

Ministry of Defence of the Russian Federation: advanced Russian weapon systems and captured equipment – at 'Patriot' Park.

Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation: 'War Crimes of the Kyiv regime' – screening of films of the Russia Today news agency's documentary section and photographs from the war zone.

Foreign Intelligence Service of the Russian Federation: ‘Technical Security Systems for Diplomatic Missions Abroad’ – integrated security systems, video surveillance systems, inspection equipment.

Ministry of Justice of the Russian Federation: ‘Protecting the Sovereignty of the Russian State. History and Modernity’.

Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation: demonstration of the present-day capabilities of the Emergency Medicine Service of the Ministry of Health of Russia, including mobile complexes – the N.I. Pirogov National Medical and Surgical Center.

Federal Medical and Biological Agency: laboratory systems mounted on all-terrain vehicles, including those with concealed and external armor, mobile blood collection systems, UAVs and robotic medical and sanitary reconnaissance systems, a mobile negative pressure isolation module, monitoring and sampling sensors, biological contaminant analyzers, test systems for pathogen detection, infection diagnostics, etc.;

Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation: ‘A Brief History of Russophobia in Western Countries’ and ‘Commemorating the Memory of the Heroes of the Great Patriotic War and the Special Military Operation’ (in collaboration with the Russian Military Historical Society).

Federal Financial Monitoring Service of the Russian Federation: ‘Training specialized personnel for national anti-money laundering systems, engaging young people and experts in the International Financial Security Movement’ with an interactive element – a virtual financial crime detection game.

Federal Agency for the Commonwealth of Independent States, Compatriots Living Abroad, and International Humanitarian Cooperation: Russian House’ exhibition stand dedicated to promoting international development, advancing Russian education and culture, providing humanitarian aid, and implementing partnership projects.

Government of Moscow: sophisticated digital solutions for the provision of citizens’ security, including the use of artificial intelligence technologies.

Government of the Moscow Region: electronic products, robotic systems.

State Corporation for the Promotion of the Development, Manufacture, and Export of High-Tech Products ‘Rostec’: key developments of holding organizations and innovations in Russian industry in various areas of security.

State Atomic Energy Corporation ‘Rosatom’: a mock-up model of a physical security system for nuclear facilities, a rapidly deployable alarm

system, a mobile video surveillance system, a search and inspection system, and an explosive detector.

State Space Corporation ‘Roscosmos’: products of the rocket and space industry companies, a working prototype of the ‘Aktiv-2’ knee module prosthesis, an exhibition dedicated to the 65th anniversary of the first man-in-space flight with a video demonstration.

JSC ‘Rosoboronexport’: small arms, tactical gear, UAVs, communications and reconnaissance equipment, non-lethal weapons, demonstrations of military and special equipment using digital platforms and virtual reality technologies.

JSC ‘Sberbank of Russia’: ‘Aletheia Cybersecurity’ platform – a comprehensive solution with the use of artificial intelligence to detect deepfake content online and offline at the earliest stages of an attack.

State Research Institute of Aviation Systems (GosNIIAS): a demonstrator of automatic target (object) detection and recognition technologies, an interactive demonstrator of ‘smart modeling and simulation’, a demonstrator of technologies for protecting civilian and military critical infrastructure facilities from UAVs.

Scientific-and-Expert Council of the Security Council of the Russian Federation: Russian solutions in the area of ‘electronic government’, strategic planning systems.

National Association for International Information Security (NAMIB)/Center for Coordination of Public-Private Partnerships in International Information Security (KOMIB): ‘Russian Solutions in the Area of Information Security’ – ‘Russian Cyber Security’.
